## **HUT LEASE UPDATE**

The club recently received notice of termination of the current hut lease, as of 28th November 2007. This is due to the acquisition of the Onich Hotel by a new owner. Once again the committee have made strenuous efforts to prevent the loss of the hut and have:

- Written to the new owner pointing out the history of the hut, the business for the hotel and the items within the deeds
- Obtained a letter of support from the MCofS
- Met with the new owner to discuss the future of the hut. He is aware of the deeds conditions and the condition of the hut currently.

The outcome is that we expect a new month to month lease for the hut, however this will only be until the new owner receives an opinion about developing the site from the Planning Department. In essence, we have agreed that he will not evict us from the hut until he has a firm development proposal.

The owner is open to the idea of us buying the hut and this will be discussed further by the committee, we are likely to commission a valuation to find out how much is a reasonable price.

Obviously the committee and the President want to keep the hut for use for the club and the mountaineering community and will exhaust every possible avenue to secure its future.
